Please note of the following important details:


- The only location a signature can be located on the petition is on the lines provided. Any other location cannot be counted
- A city or province, or full address must be listed next to the name for the signature to count
- The Petition can only be signed by Canadian Residents
- Each petitioner must **sign**, not print, his or her own name directly on the lines provided on the petition and must not sign for anyone else. If a petitioner cannot sign because of illness or a disability, this must be noted on the petition and the note signed by a witness.
- There is **no** age requirement for someone to sign the Petition
- Please feel free to photocopy the required amount of pages for your use.
- In order for your petitions to be accepted in to the House of Commons, you must mail the original paper copies back to the address below, faxed, or emailed copies cannot be accepted.
- Both pages 1 and two of the petition may be used.
